Annual Report (2009-10)

The Dronacharya College, is a private, self financed, non-government educational institute managed by OCEAN Society. Established in 2006 as a college of education, three Professional courses BBA,BCA and PGDCA affiliated to H.P University have also been introduced in the year 2008. The college has been allotted 200 seats in B.Ed course, 40 in BBA, 40 in BCA and 40 seats in PGDCA course. It has also been identified by National Testing Service-India , MHRD (Higher Education) for the establishment of Regional Field Unit.

Dronacharya College believes in inculcating the philosophy "Where knowledge is created, not just communicated." The College aims at imparting lifelong learning and provides a learner centric rather than teacher- centric educational process. Co-curricular activities are an integral part of education and they ensure harmonious development of an individual. Activities such as debates, declamation, quiz competition and other literary & cultural activities are frequently held for the students. Workshops, Conferences, Guest lectures, Seminar and. Educational tours strive to widen intellectual horizon of the pupils. The college prepares professionals who are equipped with required skills and competencies to meet the challenges of the competitive world. The whole some development of the professional students is taken care of through personality development programmes, yoga and enlightened talks by the renowned personalities.

Vision

Dronacharya envisions to nurture and train pupil-teachers with ethical values, vibrant knowledge and professional skills, so that they become a useful instrument in the national development and peace.

Infrastructure:

The college has a state of the art infrastructural facilities which are designed to cater to all the needs of the students. It is housed in a spacious, pollution free campus of over 15 kanals. The classrooms are large and airy, equipped with desks, curtains, signor boards, blackboard and lecture stands. Apart from this it has Principal's office, Administrative office, Staffroom, Girls Common room, Seminar Hall, Psychology, Science Lab, hostel and canteen facilities.

The institution added many more facilities in the year 2009-10 and some of them are

- The campus was made Wi-Fi enabled with round the clock broadband connectivity and 15 new computers were added to the computer lab.
- A well furnished language lab was operationalised to make the students improve their spoken and listening skills.
- Art and craft centre has been set up to showcase the creative, intellectual and aesthetic sense of the students.
- Three LCD projectors were acquired to make learning more interesting by promoting the use of ICT in teaching-learning process.
- A new Photostat machine has been installed in the library to meet the requirements of the students and faculty.
- All library records and students 'details have been computerized.
- The work of making Seminar hall air-conditioned is going on .
- Besides this the construction of new BBA-BCA block is underway and it is likely to be completed by Sep,2010.

Library:

The role of library in an educational institution is of utmost importance and is considered as the heart of the institution.

The college library has 7950 books in different disciplines to cater for the academic needs of the students . The library subscribes for 20 journals, 17 magazines and 10 newspapers. It has a vast treasure of encyclopedias , Educational CDs & DVDs. The library service is catalogued and a reprographic machine is installed To meet the requirements of needy students , the college has started a book bank .

Staff:

At Present, the college has adequate teaching staff and non-teaching staff. In teaching faculty there are 25 lecturers and all of them are highly qualified and experienced .Non teaching staff include a professionally qualified librarian, administrative officer, office superintendent, clerk and class IV employees .All the members of staff are highly motivated, enthusiastic and committed to the goals of the institution which are well reflected in its vision, mission, objectives and values. They are working beyond the college working hours to make Dronacharya college a leading institution not only in Himachal but also at national and international level. The following are the glorious achievements of the staff this year.

Academic achievements:

In the third session of B.Ed. (2008-09) Mrs. Sakshi Sharma secured 1st position in the college by obtaining 841 marks which is highest in the history of Dronacharya college.

In PGDCA session (2009-10) Ms. Shweta Thakur attained 3rd position in HP University 1st Semester Examination by securing 476 marks.

In the year (2008-09) Mr. Anil Kumar of BBA-IInd Semester and Ms. Gurminder Kaur of BCA-Ist year secured lst position in the college by obtaining 401 and 692 marks respectively.

In the year 2009-10 Ms Anitika Katoch of BBA-Ist semester and Mr. Suraj Singh of BBA-IIIrd semester secured lst position in the college.

Other Achievements:

- i) We have been able to establish NTS Regional Field Unit in the college for secondary school level.
- ii) Due to the rigorous efforts of faculty members the college has been nominated for international red-ribbon award.
- iii) The college has set up a NSS unit, Rovers and Rangers Club, Rotaract club and red ribbon club and many other clubs this year.
- iv) The faculty members have successfully organized National Level Seminar, three State Level workshops and orientation programme in the college.
- v) Our Staff have also presented papers and participated in various seminars and Workshops organized by other colleges in Himachal and other states. Some of them include National Seminar on "Quality management in teacher education" at Ghaziabad (U.P), National Seminar on "ICT: A boon for quality education" at Karnal (Haryana), etc.
- vi) Articles of some teachers have been published in leading newspapers.
- vii) With the serious endeavour and support of faculty members the college has conducted National Level Language Test in Hindi across the entire state of Himachal Pradesh.

House Examination:

In the month of February House Examination for B.Ed were conducted in which Ms. Swati Dogra secured 516 marks and stood first. Ms. Sunaina Walia secured 483 marks and stood second while Ms. Tenzin Kyizom secured 479 marks and got third position . Apart from this, Unit tests and assignments were also taken to evaluate the performance of the students from time to time.

In BBA-IInd Sem. House Examination Ms. Chander Rekha and Ms. Priya Sohal secured Ist and 2^{nd} Positions . In BBA-IV Sem. House Examination Mr. Suraj Singh and Mr. Shekhar Sharma secured Ist and 2^{nd} Position .

In BCA-Ist year Ms. Mehak Mahajan and Mr. Nitesh Rana secured Ist and 2nd Positions. While in BCA-IInd year Ist and 2nd Positions were secured by Mr. Sachin Guleria and Mr. Rajinder Rajan respectively.

Co-Curricular Activities:

Co-Curricular Activities are the integral part of education and plays an important role in harmonious and all round development of an individual. Student have abundant energy and stamina. In order to use best part of their energy various activities are organized to maintain balance between body and mind .

On the commencement of fourth session, "Talent Hunt" comprising of various activities like geet, gazal, skit, etc. were organized on 30th October 2009. On this day Alumni Association and Parent Teacher Association (PTA) was also constituted.
