The Dronacharya College is a private, self financed, non-aided educational institute managed by OCEAN Society. Established in 2006 as a College of Education, three professional courses BBA, BCA and PGDCA affiliated to H.P University have also been introduced in the year 2008. The college has been allotted 200 seats in B.Ed. course, 60 in BBA, 40 in BCA and 40 seats in PGDCA course. To envisage the competitive world the College is striving hard to provide quality education since its inception and has been accredited by 'National Assessment & Accreditation Council' with 'B' Grade (with a CGPA of 2.32) in 2010. The college is also recognized by UGC under section 2(f) of UGC Act 1956. It has also been identified by National Testing Service-India, MHRD (Higher Education) for the establishment of a Regional Field Unit.

The College aims at imparting a learner centric rather than teacher- centric education. It prepares professionals who are equipped with required skills and competencies to meet the challenges of the competitive world. The whole some and integrated personality is achieved through personality development programmes, yoga and enlightened talks of renowned personalities. Teachers are the beacons who empower pupils to make the wind favourable to their journey and help them set sail to reach further academically and ethically.

Infrastructure:

The college has state of the art infrastructural facilities to cater to the students from diverse background. It is situated in a spacious, pollution free campus of over 15 kanals. Air conditioned seminar hall, psychology resource centre, science & maths resource centre, hostel and canteen are among other facilities.

The institution added many more facilities in the year 2011-12 and some of them are:

- A smart class room with Learn next teaching software was made operational.
- Three computers and a printer were added to the computer lab which enhanced the existing potential of Wi-Fi enabled ICT facilities of the institution.
- An additional room and a soft beverage showcase fridge have been added in the College canteen to enhance the seating capacity and availability of soft drinks.
- All library records and students details have been computerized and about 200 books were added.
- An open air stage with ramp is constructed.
- A solar geyser is fitted for the use of hostel occupants.

Library:

The role of library in an educational institution is of utmost importance and is considered as the heart of the institution. To cater the academic demands of students, the college has rich library equipped with more than 10,000 books. There are more than 23 educational and research journals, 19 magazines along with 9 daily newspapers. It has a vast treasure of Encyclopedias, Educational CDs & DVDs. The library service is catalogued and a reprographic machine is installed. To meet the requirements of needy students the college has started a book bank. New and latest reading material is made available to the students.

Staff:

The college has adequate teaching and non-teaching staff. About 25 highly qualified and experienced lecturers' take care of all the academic requirements of the students while a professionally qualified librarian, office superintendent, clerk and class IV employees provides selfless support and services. All the members of staff are highly motivated, enthusiastic and committed to the goals of the institution which are well reflected in its vision, mission, objectives and values. They are working beyond the college working hours to make Dronacharya College a leading institution not only in Himachal but also at national and international level.

- 3. Guidance and Counseling cell provides career and personal guidance to the students. Placement cell for students is an important initiative of the college. Placement officer maintains close liaison with potential employers.
- 4. State Level Declamation Contest is an annual feature of this institution.
- 5. Awards are given to meritorious students who excel academically as well as in other activities.
- 2. College's Internal Quality Assurance Cell ensures overall quality in the functioning of the institution.
- 3. Various Co-curricular activities are organized to nurture pupil's talents.
- 4. The Principal regularly monitors the performance of the institution by holding review meetings and suggests measures for maintenance.
- 5. Grievance Redressal Cell of the college takes care of the grievances of the students. A 'Khula Darbar' is organised for the students to voice their grievances and immediate solution is provided.
- 6. There is a well equipped central computer lab with computers. College also has internet (Wi-Fi) facility. Lab is also equipped with a printer and a scanner.
- 7. College library has stocked more than 8000 books, 18 journals and 20 magazines. Books can be issued or returned on all working days. It is equipped with a computer and a photocopier.
- 8. Book bank facility is provided to poor and deserving students

- 9. Self appraisal is practiced by the staff. Feedback is collected from the students for the improvement of program and facilities.
- 10. Community oriented activities such as AIDS awareness programme, blood donation camp etc. are organised through NSS and they inculcate among them a sense of civic response.
- 11. A Communication skills, soft skills and Personality development Programme "SMARTSKILLS" specially tailored made for the rural students to improve their communication skills.
- 12. Extensive use of modern teaching aids such as OHP, LCD, models and charts are made.
- 13. Regular extension lectures, workshops and seminars add to the extension dimension of the college.
- 14. Employees Provident Fund is provided for the welfare of the employees.
- 15. The college has active alumni association, which takes interest in the activities of the college and also helps in mobilizing resources.
- 16. The college magazine "Lakshya "is published every year. It is a student's initiative to give expression to their thoughts or feelings in it.
- 17. College organises cultural events, sports and games events, debates, and dance/music competitions etc from time to time.
- 18. Parent-Teachers Association of the college undertakes community centered activities.
- 19. College prepares academic calendar at the beginning of the academic year.

- 20. College has been chosen as a Regional Field Unit by National Testing Service, MHRD; Govt. of India for improving the evaluation procedure of Indian languages.
- 21. Beautification Committee and four houses attend to the maintenance of the campus.
- 22. Student teaching is CD- recorded and replayed for purpose of assessment.
- 23. College publishes its updated prospectus annually.
- 24. College has well equipped classrooms, auditorium, E.T lab, language lab, Science lab, Social Science lab and Psychology lab.
- 25. Involvement of the maximum number of staff in academic and administrative matters through various committees.
- 26. There is a complete absence of Ragging in the campus.
- 27. In Peer teaching, advanced learner helps academically disadvantaged student.
- 28. Women Empowerment cell attends to the problems of the female students.
- 29. In order to facilitate the use of technology in learning a Smart Class room in the college is functional.
- 30.To promote research culture in the college, action research in different areas of education is undertaken.
- 31. Awards are given to meritorious students who excel academically as well as in other activities.
- 32. College organizes an Annual Fest- NAVRANG every year in which inter college literary, sports and cultural events are organized.

- 33. Monetary Award of Rs 10000/- and Rs 5000/- is given to the university first and second position holders .
- 34. In college, special classes are undertaken for the preparation of Entrance Exams. i.e. TET, CTET etc.
- 35. The year 2013-14 will be celebrated as the 'Stakeholders Participation in Quality Enhancement' to promote stakeholders maximum participation.

36.Internal Quality Assurance Cell(IQAC) ensures active participation of students in college decision making process by electing representative from the students in the form of 'STUDENT COUNCIL'.

37.An active system of Feedback from students ensures quality progession in the college.

38.Our pupil —teachers are talented and creative in order to explore their latent potential college has constituted four houses i.e Swami Vivekananda House, Tagore House, Radhakrishna House, Kalam House. Every month an interaction meeting of all the houses to elect student incharges and to discuss on the activities to be organized is held in the presence of House Incharge (Faculty). Each week, Morning Assembly activity, Cultural and literary contests are organized by the house on duty. Numerous Intra College Competitions are organized throughout the year and during Annual Prize Distribution Ceremony 'A Best House of the Year Award' is given to the best house.

39. Every year an interactive 'Principal Meet' is organized with the Principals of different schools to encourage sharing of ideas and improve teaching practice.

40.A one week 'Art of living' course is organized every year to teach students and faculty how to live a life full of happiness and contentment. Yoga & Meditation classes are organized in the college to relieve the stress.

41. A Career Counselling programme 'SPARK' to counsel students on career prospects has met with a tremendous success.

42. College holds the distinction of being the first college in Himachal to organize a literary and cultural extravaganza an Annual College fest-NAVRANG.
