Infrastructure:

The college has state of the art infrastructural facilities to cater to the students from diverse background. It is situated in a spacious, pollution free campus of over 15 kanals. Air conditioned seminar hall, Psychology resource centre, Science & Maths resource centre, Hostel and Canteen are among other facilities.

The institution refurbished its facilities in the year 2013-14 and some of them are:

- A smart class room with **Learn-Next** teaching software was made operational.
- Three computers and a printer were added to the computer lab that enhanced the existing potential of Wi-Fi enabled ICT facilities of the institution.
- An additional room to enhance the seating capacity of the canteen has been added.
- A soft drink beverage showcase cum fridge have been installed in the College canteen.
- All library records and students details have been computerized.
- 200 new books were added in the College library.
- An open air stage with a ramp is constructed for organizing cultural functions.
- A solar geyser is installed for the use of hostel occupants.

Library:

The role of library in an educational institution is of utmost importance and is considered as the heart of the institution. To cater the academic demands of students, the college has rich library equipped with more than 12,500 books. There are more than 25 educational and research journals, 19 magazines along with 12 daily newspapers. It has a vast treasure of Encyclopedias, Educational CDs & DVDs. The library service is catalogued and a reprographic machine is installed. To meet the requirements of needy

students the college has started a book bank. New and latest reading material is made available to the students.

Staff:

The college has adequate teaching and non-teaching staff. About 28 highly qualified and experienced lecturers' take care of all the academic requirements of the students while a professionally qualified librarian, office superintendent, clerk and class IV employees provides selfless support and services. *** MANIFOLD ACHIEVEMENTS OF DRONACHARYA COLLEGE ***

Academic Achievements:

In the Annual Examination of B.Ed (Session-2012-13) out of 200 students 199 appeared. The pass percentage was 100% with 86 academic distinctions. Ms. Ravita Rana secured the first position securing 74.63% marks. Kanika Jariyal secured second position securing 73.63% marks. While, Ritika secured third position securing 73.18% marks.

In Unit tests held for B.Ed. students in the month of November, Deepika stood first by securing 213 marks. Whereas Anu Kumari stood second by securing 212 marks and Manju Devi earned third position by securing 196 marks.

In house tests held for B.Ed students Anu secured first position by securing 439 marks whereas Deepika and Ankita stood on second and third position by securing 436 and 395 marks respectively.

In BCA-III year exam, 35 students appeared whereas in BBA-III exam year 29 students appeared in the Annual Exam. Overall, the pass percentage was 100%. BBA and BCA students brought glory to the institution by securing meritorious positions in the Academics. In BCA Final year, Ranjeeta Kumari stood first, Sonakshi Gupta stood second and Harshi Mankotia stood Third. In BCA 2nd year, Manisha stood first, Miliya Mahajan stood second and Sunita stood third. In BCA first year, Dinozi stood first, Pammi Devi stood second and Isha stood third. Similarly, In BBA Final year, Shabnam

stood first, Gaurav stood second, and Bharti stood third. In BBA second year, Manisha Devi stood First, Vijay Kumar and Ankush stood second and Shivali stood third. In BBA First year, Shivangi stood first, Komal stood second and Chandan Sharma stood third.
