MORNING SESSION (10:55-11:35am)

TOPIC: Orientation on Syllabi

Resource Person: Dr.Kanika Kapoor

SESSION -1

The inaugural of Orientation programme for B.Ed –IIIrd Semester commenced with chanting of shloka by Asst.Prof.Amit Sharma followed by welcome address by the Executive Director,Mr.B.S Pathania. Dr.Kanika Kapoor commenced with detailed orientation on course curricula of third semester of B.Ed. course.She explained the general instructions /rule regarding attendance ,discipline and library. She exhaustively explained the mark scheme of all the pedagogy subjects.

SESSION-2 (11:35-12:25pm)

TOPIC: Orientation about the Internship

Resource Persons: Asst.Prof Anita Chandel & Asst.Prof. Kritika Katoch

Asst.Prof Anita Chandel guided students on the important components of school internship. She provided information on the Management structure, functioning ,Mid Day Meal, Scheme, procedure of CCA, Admission and withdrawal register, Stock register. She elaborated on the school activities to be carried out during 4 weeks (One Month Internship programme). Asst.Prof. Kritika Katoch discussed the preparation of following reports i.e. Management Structure, School Organization, preparation of various school records. She informed pupil teachers that they will observe total of 20 lessons 10 per teaching subjects. Observation of two lessons daily of the concerned school teachers on the observation format provided by the college is mandatory and record has to be maintained. She informed that pupil-teacher will prepare various school records: Teacher's Diary , Time Table of the School, Teacher's Attendance Register, Students Attendance Register, Admission and Withdrawal Register, Stock Register, School Academic and Co-curricular Calendar . School Internship Phase -II was also discussed with the pupil teachers. They were facilitated understanding of 50 Macro Lessons in each Teaching Subject; 01 Discussion Lesson in each Teaching Subject; 30 Observation Lessons in Each Teaching Subject (Total 60 Lessons).

SESSION-3 (12:40-01:10 pm)

TOPIC: Orientation on Simulation

Resource Persons: Asst.Prof. Shikha Koundal & Asst.Prof. Meenakshi Sharma Asst.Prof.Meenakshi Sharma explained the characteristics, steps and objectives of simulation.She explained the Regional College of Education,Mysore approach of Lesson Planning. She further explained the steps of a lesson plan to the students with RCEM approach She elucidated the framing of instructional objectives , previous knowledge testing, announcement of the topic , presentation incorporating teacher and pupil activities, recapitulation, evaluation and home assignment. She explained the steps with the help of a lesson plan on photo synthesis of science.

In the morning, Asst. Asst.Prof. Shikha Kaundal exhaustively explained about the process of simulation and lesson plan format to be followed during simulation. She also emphasized on the steps of RCEM approach for lesson planning to be followed by pupil teachers during simulation.






