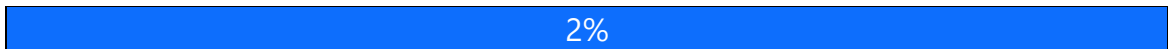

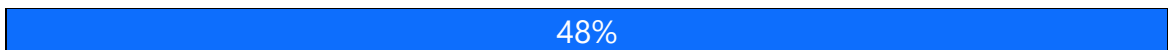


3. What percentage of teachers are effectively communicating domain knowledge, IT skills, and Soft Skills in the Teaching-Learning Process?

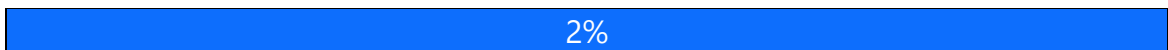

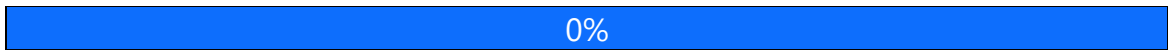

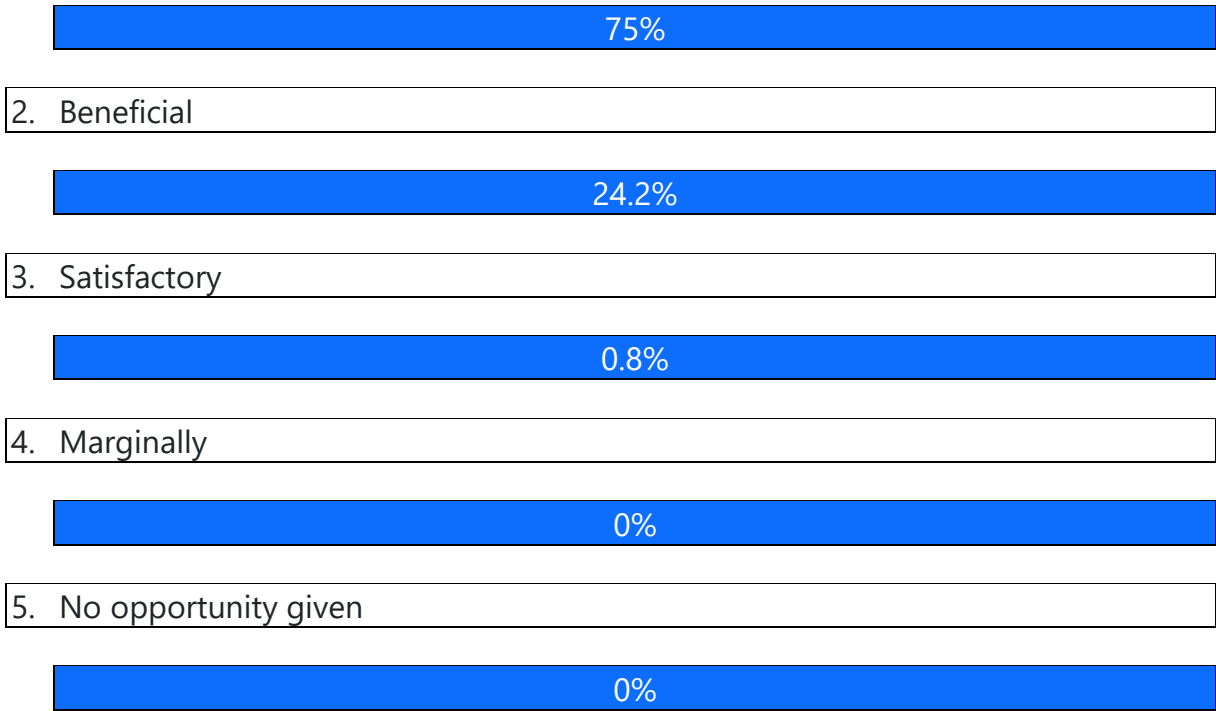


14. What level of monitoring and evaluation is available in your institution for assessing the effectiveness and interactives of the classroom/learning sessions?

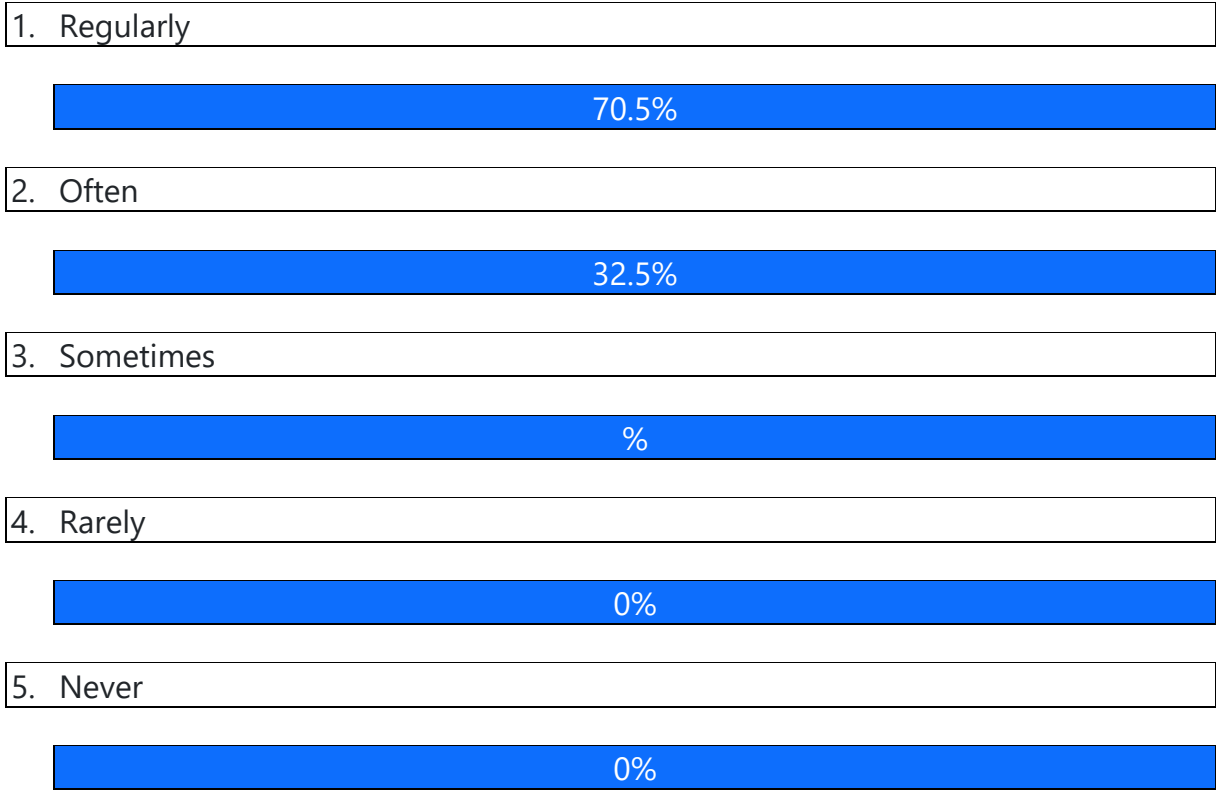
